September Activities and Curriculum

Literacy Centers

- This month we will begin our year playing “name games” and learning about being a friend. We will read several books about the beginning of school and making new friends.
- We will introduce letter Ff the last week of September as we begin our weekly letter instruction.
- Mystery letter bags will also begin the last week of September and this will help children with learning beginning letter sounds as well as letter identification.
