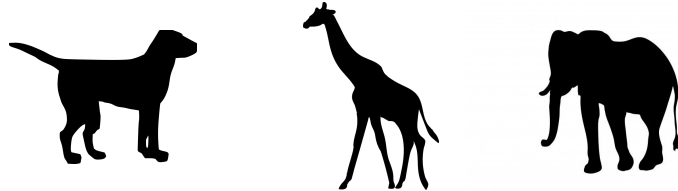




## March 3's Classroom Newsletter
