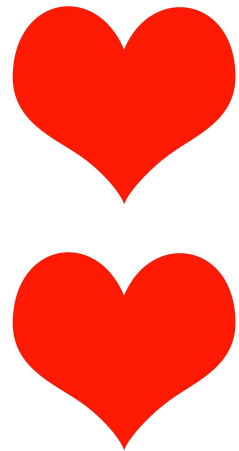




# February Newsletter
