March is going to be a fun, busy and short month due to spring break. We have so many fun activities and projects we will be doing. We will be celebrating St. Patrick's Day (the kids should be on the lookout for Leprechauns visiting our classroom!)

We will continue our lessons on patterning/rhyming and sorting as well as opposites. We talk about these on a daily basis and will continue to do so until the end of the school year. Chapel is on March 4th. We will be learning about gentleness. We will have Stretch N Grow on March 10th and Mother's Nature will be visiting our school on March 16th. The class will also get to enjoy the Tap-it with Miss Windy on March 19th.

Our letters this month are "Uu", "Vv", "Ww" and "Xx". We will continue to incorporate letter sounds and beginning sounds into our daily lesson. We will learn about the number 20 and then we will do number review for the rest of the year. Some of our art projects include vegetable prints, painting with wax paper, X-ray handprints and doing a few St. Patrick's Day crafts. Our 100th day of school falls on April 2nd, so we will be doing a lot of 100th day activities the week of March 30th.

Our sensory bin will be filled with floating bubble letters and numbers, St. Patrick's Day items and fish gravel. We will learn about life cycles at the Science center. We will also play with St. Patrick's Day slime/play-doh, and water beads. In our math center, the children will be learning counting/numbers with our pot of gold number match game, clover bump counting game, shamrock sorting and rainbow number tracing.

This month we will have a St. Patrick's Day writing station. The writing station is a favorite of the class and a great way for them to practice writing words. They will also be tracing their first and last names and writing 4 (or more if they wish) words that begin with the letter of the week. They'll have the choice to play many fun games including the cats hat beginning sound match, rainbow rhyming

puzzles, leprechaun's hide and seek letters and matching uppercase/lowercase letters on gold coins.

Our dramatic play area will be a space station and vet hospital.
